

Privacy Statement European Go Cultural Centre

Introduction

European Go Cultural Centre (hereinafter "EGCC") is committed to protecting the privacy of its customers and visitors, and endeavours to ensure that their personal data are held securely and treated with the utmost care. EGCC therefore complies with the requirements of the Dutch Personal Data Protection Act (AVG) and the General Data Protection Regulation of the European Union (GDPR). The party responsible for data processing is EGCC, Schokland 14, 1181 HV Amstelveen, the Netherlands.

Personal Data Processing

Personal data is captured by EGCC in the course of providing its services. This occurs, for example, when you rent a hall, order promotion materials, take part in an exhibition or bazaar, register an interest in one of our services, like the participation in Go competitions, or contact EGCC for another reason. The personal data we hold includes information such as contact details and transaction particulars. EGCC uses this information to fulfill and process agreements with you and operate our internal business processes. When you participate in domestic or international Go tournaments organised by EGCC, your results will be published on our website and shared with the [European Go Database \(EGD\)](#), with your full name and nationality. For the competition of the [Worldwide Iwamoto Awards](#), we collect contact details of the participants and jury members.

When you participate in the Iwamoto Awards, your name and project information will be published on our website and possibly shared with other contacts in our network and institutes interested in the promotion of Go.

As a professional promoter of Go, the EGCC holds an intermediary function and we will share the knowledge and information of Go promotional projects with certain stakeholders, always keeping into account the privacy wishes of others.

As a mindsports and cultural centre, EGCC publishes news articles about activities in our building. Names and pictures of individuals and organisations may be included.

EGCC keeps personal data of its customers for seven years after the last transaction, in compliance with the regulations and terms of the Dutch Tax Authority. In case of competitions and tournaments, this information is kept for an indefinite period for historical purposes.

Storage of Data

EGCC processes and stores data through the following digital mediums:

- Facebook (social media presence)
- Twitter (social media presence)
- YouTube (social media presence)
- Office365 (internal technical and organisational purposes)
- Afas Online (accountancy)

Cookies

Like many websites we use 'persistent cookie' technology. Persistent cookies are small text files that this website places on your computer, so that it can remember you when you show up later. None of these cookies are stored nor save any of your personal information.

Camera Supervision

EGCC uses permanent camera supervision in the building, for the protection of our visitors, property and employees and for the prevention of theft. This supervision is permanently active. We store this footage for a period of four weeks. When an incident or theft occurs, the video material is saved until the issue has been resolved.

Your Rights concerning your Personal Data

EGCC enables you to view and correct your personal data. You can request EGCC by mail or by post for access to your data. If the information is incorrect, you may alter it. You have the right to ask us to remove your personal data and/or transfer this information to another organisation.

Besides your rights of access and rectification, you have the right to withdraw your permission for personal data processing, to ask deletion of your personal data or to make objections against the way we process your data. We will do everything in our power to comply with your request(s). If you consider our treatment of your requests or objections inadequate, you have the right to send a complaint to the Dutch Data Protection Authority (Autoriteit Persoonsgegevens, DPA).
